### September Morning Arrangements

Many children, particularly in Key Stage 2, have expressed an interest in being in school rather than on the playground during the early morning session. In an attempt to suit these older pupils and to alleviate the issue of traffic in corridors when entering the school, we are going to introduce a new system for coming in to school which will hopefully result in a prompt start to class sessions.

- 1. ALL pupils will enter school through the school hall. Any pupils arriving to school after 8.45am will also go through the school hall rather than the rear gate.
- 2. From 8.45am, any Key Stage 2 pupils may put their belongings away and enter the classroom. This can be from the hall after 8.45am or directly from the playground. Foundation Phase pupils will remain on the playground as their classrooms are often being prepared for the day ahead.
- 3. When the school bell sounds, the remaining Key Stage 2 pupils will walk directly to class. Foundation Phase pupils will line up outside their cloakroom doors at the rear of the school.

#### REQUESTS

- All children need to enter the school through the school hall. No pupils or adults should go to the rear gates.
- Please make appointments to see class teachers.
- Please pass morning messages on via Breakfast Club staff (Miss C Davies or Mrs E Davies) unless urgent. If it is an urgent matter, then the Breakfast Club staff will check if the class teacher is available for you. Alternatively, school staff are always visible and available at the end of the school day.
