September Arrangements/Times


- 1. Breakfast club doors open at 8.00am for childcare (£2.50) and the free breakfast club children (Reception Year 6) need to be in school between 8.30am & 8.45am.
- 2. Arrival If you are not using Breakfast Club, staff members will be available at the gate between 8.55am and 9.00am for parents to drive down and drop children off at the entrance to the gate. Nursery will open at 1.00pm the class teacher will meet you at the gate towards the top of the car park.
- 3. At home time, Nursery will come out at 3.00pm, followed by Reception Year 2 children at 3.10pm, and Year 3 Year 6 children at 3.15pm.

Nursery parents only (unless directed) should park in the car park adjacent to the drive and all other parents should park on the street until called down by a member of staff.
