








All pupils and staff thoroughly enjoyed the pantomime. And Mr. Thomas even got some attention from the Dame!

We finally managed to do our sponsored walk to Mostyn Estates. The Mostyn Estates staff there were really generous with snacks and the weather was just perfect for a walk.


An amazing £489.70 was raised and this will all go towards outdoor play equipment and appropriate storage.

- The Christmas Eve Crib service will take place at 4pm for families. All are welcome to attend.


#### **School**
