



Our main theme this term is Diversity and topics include:


Dosbarth 1 - Ready, Steady, Grow

- new external storage facilities

- replacement of one main gas boiler
- replacement of our main water boiler
- installation of external shelter/canopy to the Foundation area

Reception & Nursery Applications


Reception applications have all been received and parents will be notified by 17/4/24.




